The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton, First District Commissioner James Gohagan, and Second District Commissioner Don Williams was absent.

Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to approve today's agenda. Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (aye) and Commissioner Skelton (aye). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

Prior Minutes

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to approve Thursday, May 2, 2024 meeting minutes. Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (aye) and Commissioner Skelton (aye).

New Business

Collector- Bid Opening- 240507 Tax Sale Publication Bid- Nobody was present to represent the Collector's Office. Commissioners Gohagan and Skelton opened two sealed bids; one from Lake Sun for \$295 per broad sheet and the other from The Reporter for \$320 per broadsheet. It was stated that, in prior years, the Collector typically chooses the bid that is the cheapest. The past two years, that company has been Lake Sun. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to accept Lake Sun's bid for the 2024 Tax Sale Publication. Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion.

Road and Bridge- Bid Opening- Asphalt Overlay- There was only one sealed bid received for this bid opening, and it was from Capital Paving. This bid includes projects for 21 county roads and milling services for a total of \$1,499,780.00.

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to accept the bid from Capital Paving upon the recommendation of the Camden County Road and Bridge Administrator, Pat Wolf. Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (aye) and Commissioner Skelton (aye).

Surplus Funds Request- \$67,215.19- The details of this request have been reviewed and OK'd by the Camden County Treasurer and Legal Counselor. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to approve the surplus request of \$67,215.19. Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. Payment Terms:

Actual quantities for billing purposes for unit price contracts are to be determined by field measurements upon completion of project. All material is guaranteed to be as specified, and the above work is to be performed in accordance with the drawings and specifications submitted for above work and completed in a substantial workmanlike manner. Payment to be made in full within 30 days of invoice date. A charge of 1 1/2% will be added to the unpaid balance until paid in full.

Any alteration or deviation from above specifications will become an extra charge. All agreements contingent upon strikes, accidents or delays beyond our control. Owner to carry fire, tornado and other necessary insurance on above work. Workmens' Compensation and Public Liability Insurance on above work is carried by the Company.

NOTE: This proposal may be withdrawn if not accepted within 30 days.


