The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton, First District Commissioner James Gohagan, and Second District Commissioner Don Williams.

Prior Minutes

Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve July 1, 2024 meeting minutes. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

New Business

Road & Bridge bid opening- Single Radius Arch Multi 3 Plate Structure 240128-V- There were three bids received. Welborn Sales' bid is for a single radius arch structure 14' span x 4'8" rise x 55LF long (12 gage, galvanized) for a total of \$14,850.00. Viebrock Sales' bid is for a single radius arch structure 14' x 4'8" x 55' (12 guage, galvanized) for a total of \$35,000.00. The final bid is from Metal Culverts, Inc. for a plain galvanized plate pipe arch 14' x 4'7.5" x 55' for a total of \$16,255.25. The Road & Bridge Administrator was unable to be present for the meeting today, but he did request that the bids be tabled until he can review them. Commissioner Williams made a motion to table these bids upon the request of the Camden County Road and Bridge Administrator. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. 

Board of Equalization- board appointments- Stacy Shore, George Pruitt, & John McCann- The Camden County Commission is appointing three new board members to the Camden County Board of Equalization as to form a whole new board. Commissioner Skelton read aloud a portion of state statute 138.085 that outlines the requirements for the Board of Equalization.

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to appoint John McCann to the Camden County Board of Equalization for a one-year-term. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (aye) and Commissioner Williams (aye).

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to appoint Stacy Shore to the Camden County Board of Equalization for a three-year-term. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (aye) and Commissioner Williams (aye).

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to appoint George Pruitt to the Camden County Board of Equalization for a two-year-term. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (aye) and Commissioner Williams (aye).

June 2024 Tax Abatements- Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to approve the June 2024 tax abatements previously tentatively ratified by a county commissioner or employee of the county commission. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (aye) and Commissioner Williams (aye).

Other/Old Business

TCLA Lodging Tax- County Atty. Jeff Green was asked to address some of the different speculations circulating around the county about the Tri-County Lodging Association Lodging Tax that the Missouri Supreme Court recently ruled unconstitutional. At this time, there has been no direction for the funds that currently exist in holding with the county and other entities around the county. Mr. Green stated that it is his position that everyone should hold the funds and

not attempt to distribute at this time because there is no direction from the courts, yet. There is no known timeline of when direction will be given or court appointed trustees will be appointed. There were no motions made on this matter.

ARPA Deadline- Commissioner Skelton alerted all present that the deadline the county has mailed letters out for has come and gone, so the county will begin clawing that money back or granting extensions to those recipients that truly need it and have proof of plans/contracts in place to have work completed. There were no motions made on this matter.

County Atty. Jeff Green wanted to make everyone aware that the Casenet website used by courts throughout the state has been inoperable for the past 48 hours and counting. Courts are struggling with getting anything accomplished, and this effects every judicial circuit statewide. He also stated that this could effect the Supreme Court which could hinder information being available regarding the lodging tax. There were no motions made on this matter.

Commissioner Williams brought up an issue of confusion from yesterday's meeting regarding county road petitions and said he was working on drafting a clear outline of the process. The county atty. would then review the outline and make any changes; then it could be submitted to the County Clerk's office for review/adoption if they wish to use it. It is Commissioner Williams' intent to alleviate some confusion/headache with the process.

There was a citizen present to represent the Ozarks Amphitheater, Tom Abbott. He was alerting the commission to some issues they have seen recently with their larger shows that cause traffic to back up tremendously and for hours at a time. Directors of Ozarks Amphitheater recently met with an engineer and discussed having a report put together with ideas for alleviating some traffic issues as the venue only hopes to continue growing in size. They currently have the issue of more parking figured out, but it's Mr. Abbott's hope that eventually there could be a turn lane added that would increase traffic flow. This would require meetings

with the city, county, and state road departments. There were no motions made on this matter.

Adjourn: With no further official business on the agenda, Commissioner Williams made a motion to adjourn to any unofficial business that may develop during the day. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye). Session closed at 10:46 A.M.

Ordered that the Commission adjourn until further notice.
