Discuss information/update on Automatic License Plate Readers- The state of Missouri reached out to Commissioner Skelton regarding his proposal of removing an ALPR off county property located in the state's right-of-way. Commissioner Skelton then submitted a Sunshine Request relating to all correspondance and documents that have to do with Flock (the company who

sells the ALPR equipment). Upon reviewing such documents received from the Sunshine Request, Commissioner Skelton discovered that the state does not own that equipment/property; it's owned, maintained, and installed by a separate entity called Axon. Commissioner Skelton has requested additional documentation and stated that his next steps are to-be-determined.
